Western Red Cedar Product Features



No man-made material can duplicate the depth of cedar's natural lustre. With its exceptional beauty, warmth and natural grains, and its subtly aromatic fragrance, Western Red Cedar is versatile, strong, extremely energy efficient and an eye-catching addition to any building design.

Wideline's Western Red Cedar is chosen from the planting stage in the managed forests of Canada where controlled harvests, natural regeneration and reforestation programs ensure an ongoing harvest.

Once at our factories, the timber weathers naturally in the open air of NSW's Central Coast for at least 3-4 months. Then, and only then, is it right for making into Wideline windows and doors.

Our craftspeople work the cedar ensuring its natural beauty is maintained and enhanced. We do not match our timbers deliberately, capturing in a window or door the various hues of the cedar, from rich honeys and blonde tones through varying shades of natural browns and reds. For extra strength, traditional woodworking techniques are maintained through traditional mortice & tenoning.

Interestingly, Western Red Cedar contains natural oils that act as preservatives that help resist insect attack and decay. Cedar is also a dimensionally stable wood that lies flat and stays straight. Properly finished and maintained, your Wideline cedar windows and doors will age gracefully and endure for many years.

Additionally, all products are dipped into a water-based weather protector to last for 6-8 weeks for those products being stained, alternatively priming is also available for products that are going to have a paint finish. Double Hung Windows



Apart from adding to the look, feel and comfort of your home, double hung windows are designed to filter light and control ventilation and heat.

Wideline's Western Red Cedar double hung windows are designed to be simple to use – the sashes are guided for the smoothest quietest operation and internal protection from the elements.

Wideline's tilt design means rattling sashes are a thing of the past – additional benefits include tilting inwards for easy cleaning and easy removal of the sash for staining.

With the optional extras of keyed locks and insect screens, the safety and comfort of your home is improved.

Available in Colonial, Heritage and Federation designs
– Wideline double hung windows come in two variations:

Jamb liner (Ultra)

- Tilt operation for easy cleaning
- Alternative top and bottom rails to match door combo units

Spiral (Traditional)

- Does not tilt
- Alternative top and bottom rail
- Can be adjusted to suit alternative glass weights



Awning Windows



With their vertical divisions, awning windows allow continuous views and have a clean and balanced appearance.

Hinged at the top, awning windows are designed to provide convenient operation and controlled ventilation.

The external frames offer strength in exposed areas such as buildings above 10 metres or those in cyclonic areas.

The full perimeter sash seal offer maximum weather protection as well as reducing air infiltration.

For improved safety, Wideline provides an efficient locking system and insect screens for effective protection.

Advice is also available on a number of glass options to improve acoustic and energy performance in a variety of circumstances.

Casement Windows



As well as long lasting performance, Wideline casement windows add warmth and character to your home.

Hinged at the side to swing outwards, casement windows are ideal for bringing in gentle breezes.

Wideline casement windows are fitted with an internal winder operating mechanism that controls window opening and closing. This mechanism allows easy and convenient window operation, as well as access to cleaning the exterior glass from the inside.

With a choice of different glazing, Wideline casement windows offer uninterrupted views with an option for insect screens that do not need to be removed for window operation.





Bay Windows



Elegant and attractive, Wideline's cedar bay windows add an exceptional sense of space and light to your home.

Traditional in appearance, bay windows can be customised to suit individual requirements by coupling together any combination of Wideline's cedar windows.

Available in 135 or 90 degree configurations, the bay window provides you with the option of using different styles in your bay window combinations including sliding, awning or double hung.

The bay window can be floor to ceiling – in such cases the window is glazed with 'A' grade safety glass in compliance with Australian standards AS1288.

Custom windows add individuality to your home and Wideline can manufacture windows to reflect or highlight a specific theme.

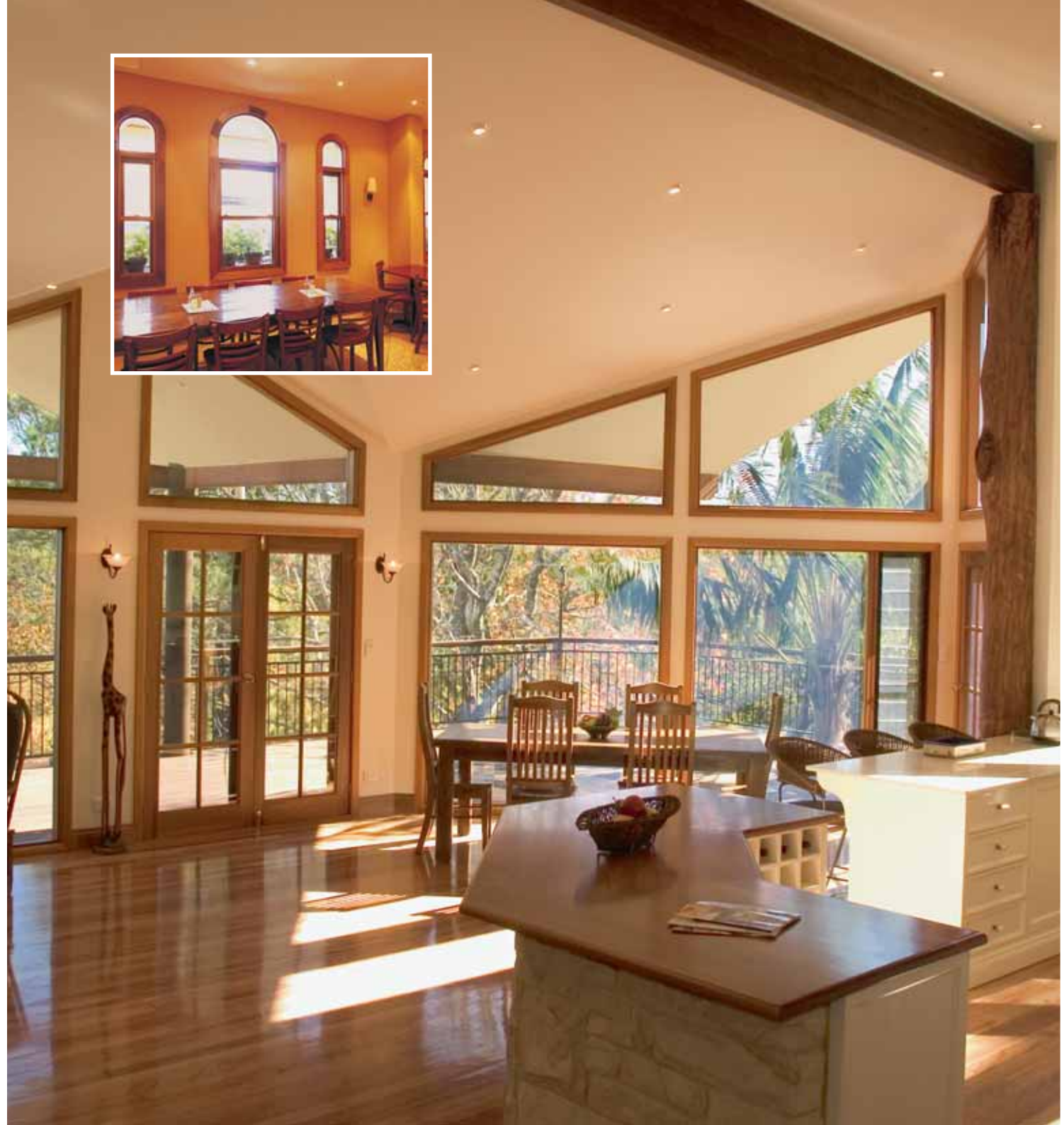

Sliding & Stacking Windows/Doors



Offering convenient entry and ventilation, sliding & stacking doors are ideal for any situation overlooking patios and gardens.

Wideline's sliding & stacking doors feature a self-draining sill and seal to prevent water penetration in compliance with Australian Standard requirements AS2047.

Designed in slim line sturdy frames – Wideline sliding doors have toughened glass with a safety motif across the centre.

They can be double-glazed for added benefits, such as insulation and noise reduction.

Sliding windows are manufactured the same way as the sliding door, ie; sturdy, strong. For added comfort, sliding windows can be fitted with a fixed or sliding insect screen – sliding screens are ideal for use on a servery window ie; between kitchen and balcony.



Joinery Doors

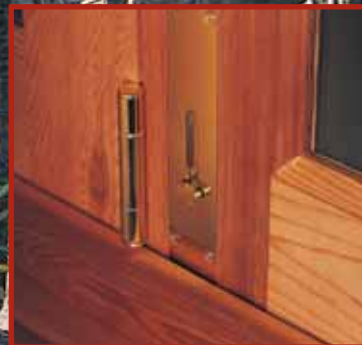

Product Maintenance



We are proud members of the Australian Window Association

Wideline is a founding member of the Australian Window Association (AWA). The Association was established to ensure that manufacturers produced windows that meet and preferably exceed stringent safety and structural standards. From material selection and workmanship quality to weather sealing and applied finishes, all aspects of production are scrutinised to ensure they meet the relevant Australian standards. The AWA label on every Wideline product means you can be confident our vast range has been tested, certified and guaranteed by independent inspectors accredited by the National Association of Testing Authorities (NATA).



Wideline products are manufactured from the most suitable materials and finishes available and when properly maintained, will give many years of quality service.

Builders/Home Owners Please Note

When you are installing windows and doors there are some precautions you should take to ensure that the products will retain their ex-factory condition until installation is complete and the job handed over. Wideline products usually arrive on the site in a fully finished condition. However, they can be damaged through careless handling, and are particularly vulnerable when being installed in brick or concrete block construction.

Remember

- Keep wet cement, mortar and brick-cleaning acid from contact with timber and aluminium (particularly if the finish is anodised), before, during and after installation.
- If accidentally splashed, wash off immediately with clean water, otherwise permanent staining or damage may occur.
- Do not use acid to remove mortar stains on window frames.
- Hose down brickwork to remove residual cleaning acid that may leach out and cause damage to the finish later.
- Do not place windows directly onto green concrete slabs.
- Keep the tracks of sliding windows and doors clear of sand and cement droppings.
- Do not use window frames to support planks or temporary scaffolding.
- Clean up when the job is complete with mild detergent and rinse with clean water.

Timber Products

All Wideline timber products are coated with a clear wood preservative. This treatment provides temporary protection for a period of 6 to 8 weeks. We recommend a surface finish be applied as soon as possible. This surface finish coating should then be maintained in good condition on both internal and external faces. This can be achieved by regular cleaning with non-abrasive cleaners and refinishing when breakdown of the coating occurs. Applied coatings and refinishing must include all edges of doors including top and bottom. Steel wool or other metallic abrasives must not be used to sand cedar and other fine grain timbers. Use fine grit sandpaper or sanding blocks.

To avoid water straining, keep tracks and sash openings clean and free of leaves and other debris that may retain water. Ensure that the weep slots in windows and doors are kept clear to allow maximum drainage.

We do not recommend the use of steel fasteners as these will result in unremovable stains.

Glass

To clean clear float glass, wipe over the surface with a few drops of methylated spirits on a damp cloth, and then polish the surface dry with a lint free cloth. Proprietary glass cleaners are not recommended as some of them can cause damage to the silver backing on mirrors and the interlay of laminated glass. Ensure that all cleaning cloths are free of any abrasive substances.

Avoid causing extreme temperature changes as this may lead to thermal fracture of the glass (i.e. do not direct hot or cold water onto glass).

For Peace of Mind

Wideline Guarantee

Your Wideline products are guaranteed against defects arising from faulty workmanship or materials for a period of ten (10) years from the date of delivery by Wideline, subject to the following conditions:

- a. The product has been installed in accordance with the relevant Australian Standards and recognised building practice.
- b. The product has been maintained in accordance with industry recommendations.
- c. The product has not been subject to misuse, physical abuse or neglect.
- d. Manufacturing standards and tolerances are not deemed defects, nor are industry variations in the colour of aluminium and timber componentry.
- e. Wideline accepts no responsibility for glass breakage (except for faulty workmanship or materials). Wire reinforced glass, toughened glass, float glass, laminated glass and mirror glass is guaranteed against defects and degradation for a period of three (3) years.
- f. Moving parts which wear out as a part of normal use are guaranteed for three (3) years.
- g. This guarantee is limited to the repair or replacement of the faulty product at the company's discretion but does not extend to the installation or refinishing of a replacement product.
- h. Finish failures or corrosion of aluminium or other components due to environmental conditions such as air pollutants, acid rain or other corrosive substances are defects which have arose due to the conditions and are therefore not the responsibility of Wideline.
- i. Corrosion, wear, or failure of standard components in seacoast applications (within 5 kilometres of coastal waters) is not covered under this warranty as deterioration is possible under climate conditions.
- j. Normal wear or discolouration of finishes including the tarnishing of brass is a result of conditions or applications and are therefore not the responsibility of Wideline.
- k. Only repairs carried out by Wideline personnel or authorised Wideline agents are covered by this guarantee.
- l. Claims under this guarantee should be made within one month of the defect arising in the product. Copies of documentation showing the purchase date of the product should be included with your written claim and forwarded to the nearest Wideline office.

This guarantee is in addition to all other rights and remedies in respect of this product to which you are entitled under the Trade Practices Act and similar State and Territory laws.
